NYSADC Fellowship in Special Needs Dentistry

The New York State Academic Dental Centers (NYSADC) is pleased to offer postdoctoral fellowship opportunities to gain advanced training in providing care for people with special needs in New York State. NYSADC is committed to addressing the gaps in access to oral health care for people with special needs – particularly those with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD).

Requirements and Responsibilities

Graduates of U.S. dental schools who have completed at least one year of postdoctoral training, are eligible for licensure in New York State and are committed to improving access to care for people with special needs are encouraged to apply.

Following the fellowship year, fellows will commit to one year in practice settings in New York State with significant special needs patient populations and continuing their teaching and research responsibilities.

Fellows will provide direct patient care in clinical settings that specialize in serving people with I/DD and devote 20% of their time to teaching and/or research at one of New York's six academic dental centers for the duration of the fellowship year.
